This agreement indicates that the student listed above is in good standing at the Proviso Mathematics and Science Academy and is interested in participating in the Research Mentorship Program. To be accepted into this program, the student and parent/guardian must agree to the terms specified below. Final placement is dependent on the availability of a Mentor in your area of interest.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT

Academics	– Student is and remains in good standing at the Academy academically and has no significant attendance and disciplinary issues over the duration of the agreement.
Decorum	– Student is be present and on time for all mentorship experiences. – Student is expected to act in accordance with all rules of behavior as outlined by PMSA and the host institution. – Student is an ambassador for the Academy and District 209, and is expected carry themselves in a manner befitting this expectation.
Ethics	– Students will exercise the highest degree of ethical decision–making during this experience, academically, socially, behaviorally, and with their research work.
Health Emergencies	– In the event of an accident, injury, or illness that occurs during the mentorship experience, PMSA will secure the same type of treatment at a proper facility that would be expected if the student were on campus. PMSA will work with host institution personnel to secure proper treatment and to notify parents and guardians as soon as possible.
Participation	– Student is to be fully involved in the activities of this mentorship. There is a minimum of a five-hour commitment on mentorship days, and includes tasks and activities as assigned my the Mentor and Academy Faculty. These include, but are not limited to: ▶ Maintaining an accurate and complete journal ▶ Participation in all workshop activities ▶ Submission of all required documents according to their deadlines ▶ Participation in the PMSA Research Symposium held in May – Student agrees to prioritize the mentorship experience above all extracurricular activities such as sports or clubs.
Safety	– Students will complete a review of all safety procedures with their Mentor during their initial meeting. This includes all biological, chemical, physical, and radiation hazards that may be present at the host site. Documentation of the hazards and any safety training will be provided to parents and guardians in the first report card mailing.
Transportation	– Students are expected to secure safe and reliable transportation to their mentorship sites. A limited amount of transportation may be provided by the Academy.
