Summer School 2010

- **SECOND SEMESTER NOTIFICATION WILL BE DELIVERED TO HOMES OF STUDENTS AFTER FINAL GRADE PROCESSING.**
- **INCOMING FRESHMEN WILL BE NOTIFIED OF RECOMMENDED ATTENDANCE AFTER RECEIPT OF EXPLORE TESTING RESULTS IN NOVEMBER /DECEMBER.**

The Illinois School Code permits mandatory summer school per the code listed below.

Illinois School Code

(105 ILCS 5/10 – 22.33B)

Sec. 10-22.33B. Summer school, required attendance. To conduct a high quality summer school program for those resident students identified by the school district as being academically at risk in such critical areas as language arts (reading and writing) and mathematics who will be entering any of the school district's grades for the next school term and to require attendance at such programs by such students who have not been identified as disabled under Article 14, but who meet criteria established under this Section. Summer school programs established under this Section shall be designed to raise the level of achievement and improve opportunities for success in subsequent grade levels of those students required to attend. The parent or guardian of any student required to attend shall be given written notice from the school district requiring attendance not later than the close of school term which immediately precedes the required summer school program.
